PURPOSE

This Policy is aimed at Ensuring the Safety of Learners who Travel by Bus or Other Means of Road Transport.

- Foundation Phase learners must be accompanied by an educator to the bus stop after school.
- Intermediate Phase learners should be accompanied in orderly lines by an educator to the bus stop after school.
- Educators should ensure that the learners who have to travel by bus actually get on the bus.
- No learner may deviate from the rule to get on or off the bus on his or her bus route. The school cannot be held responsible should a learner decide to get on or off the bus at another place out of his or her own free will.
- Written consent from the parent or guardian should be submitted to the principal if a learner wants to get on or off the bus at another place. This consent is then handed to the bus driver to ensure that it happens.
- All written consent letters should be kept in a file for the transport company in the event of any incident.

- The learners should be well informed as to the proper way to use the road, wait for the bus and wait until the bus has departed before crossing the road.
